

Cedar River Bowmen General Rules

1: The Entrance:

The first gate (Community Gate) to the Range may be left open only during Club Tournaments or for Club Business and is to be kept closed and locked at all times by all members entering or leaving the range. The second gate (Club gate) may be left open while the range is in use. The last person leaving is responsible to make sure both gates are locked.

2: Clubhouse Rules:

- a. No overnight sleeping in Clubhouse is allowed.
- b. No common Club Property may be "taken over" and used by a member for personal use.

3: Grounds:

Members using grounds for camping or picnicking are responsible for cleaning up their trash, etc. and removing it from Club property.

4: Use of Practice Butts: (Flat Range)

- a. Prior to shooting or pulling arrows on the Flat Range a "CLEAR" range command shall be used. Both Flat Range and Broadhead Range must be "Clear" before shooting or pulling arrows.
- b. No Broadheads are allowed on the practice butts.

5: Use of Broadhead Range:

Prior to shooting or pulling arrows on the Broadhead Range a "CLEAR" range command shall be used. Both Flat Range and Broadhead Range must be "Clear" before shooting or pulling arrows.

6: Use of Walk Thru Courses:

- a. There will be no backtracking or taking short cuts off trails.
- b. No Broadheads are allowed on any of the walk thru courses.
- c. Please do not litter the course with your debris. Carry out what you bring in.

7: Lost Arrows:

Anyone finding lost arrows should return them to the registration booth or arrow container at the flat range. Remember, these arrows belong to someone and are not yours to keep.

8: Work Parties:

- a. No one will use, or shoot on, any portion of the range when a work party is in progress.
- b. On all scheduled work party days and tournament set-up days, the entire range will be closed for shooting until work is completed.

9: Prohibited Uses:

- a. NO HUNTING, fireworks, air rifles or crossbows are allowed on Club property. Concealed weapons may be carried only by licensed individuals and must be kept fully concealed at all times.
- b. Horses, all-terrain vehicles (ATV's) and motor bikes are not permitted at the Club except for official Cedar River Bowmen business.

10. Dogs: Safety & Sanitation

Keep your dog under total control at all times. You, as owner, are liable for the actions of your dog. If it growls, bites, etc you are responsible. Pick up all deposits left by your dog. Dogs must be on a leash during tournaments.

11. Alcohol and Drugs:

NO consumption prior to or during shooting.

12. Safety: Sky Drawing:

To insure a safe environment always draw your bow at the ground, or level, pointed at the target you intend to shoot. "Sky" drawing or shooting is strictly prohibited. We do have neighbors that adjoin CRB property, and it is important that we adhere to these Safety Precautions, not only to ensure a safe shooting experience on CRB property, but also to ensure the safety of our neighbors, their property and families.
